RSA SecurID Readiness Checklist

In advance of RBC Investor & Treasury Services' (RBC I&TS) implementation of two-factor authentication using an RSA SecurID software token, please review the three-step checklist below.

1. Confirm Software




2. Verify you can install the RSA SecurID application that aligns with your operating system (e.g., Windows/Mac/Android/Apple iOS)


3. Verify you can connect with the RBC URL


